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### TRAVEL INFORMATION

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#### FLIGHT

Please review your airline ticket carefully and be sure to re-confirm your international flights 72 hours before departure. If you will be on Transit flight we highly recommend you carry extra clothing in cabin on your arrival flight and any of your necessities as experience tells us, if by bad luck your luggage gets misplaced or lost .

If your baggage has not arrived, you require to report to the airline officer at the airport and fill in a claim form so that we can assist in the follow up of your baggage whilst you begin your trip. Ensure you advise them that you will be in Tanzania, state all your overnights as per your itinerary and our full address so they can arrange to deliver your bags to either your overnight location or our office. Based on your airlines procedures on delayed baggage and your current location, we may be able to deliver your bags to you at an extra fee.

Luggage restriction on Domestic flights is **one 15 kg check-in** and 5kg hand luggage – duffle/soft bags are recommended. Any extras will need to be paid for approximately at Usd 6,- per extra checked in bag.

Also, to prior travelling, ensure your passport is valid for more than **6 months** from your arrival date.

**Prior to travelling to Tanzania if outside the Country, check based on your Nationality with the Tanzanian Embassy if you will get your visa on Arrival in Tanzania otherwise prearrange it much before your travel. Ensure your passport is valid for more than 6 months from your departure date.**

**Afghanistan, Abkhazia, Azerbaijan, Bangladesh, Chad, Djibouti, Ethiopia, Eritrea, Equatorial Guinea, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Lebanon, Mali, Morocco, Mauritania, Niger, Kalkstein State, Senegal, Somalia, Srilanka, Sierra eon, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan, Uzbekistan are some of the Countries that require to get prior visa before entering Tanzania .**

#### TRANSFER:

On your arrival at Kilimanjaro International Airport on KLM 567 at 7.50PM , we shall have a board with our Company Name on and your names: robert gelman x 2 , Introduce yourself and he shall transfer you to Green Mountain Hotel for your overnight.

## VACCINATION

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The **Yellow Fever** vaccine is **compulsory** for anyone entering Tanzania. Kindly consult your physician for doses and advice. Also, we highly recommend you consult your travel clinic/doctor for the latest advice on various prophylaxis available against Malaria and other tropical infections like Hepatitis, Tetanus, Typhoid and Polio.

## EMERGENCY CONTACT

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If you are delayed en-route, or miss your flight (we hope not as you will be missing in action!) you can contact us at our office, our residence in Arusha or our cell numbers and update us your expected arrival time.

**Please note:** unexpected delays on arrival transfer will be at extra fee.

Please note if you are calling from outside Africa, first use the prefix **011** before the country code **only** if in the US, otherwise use the Tanzanian country code **+255** directly followed by the Arusha city code **27** and then the phone number.

## INSURANCE

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All travelers are expected to have personal evacuation and medical insurance, in the rare case of an emergency. We strongly recommend travel insurance to cover accidents, trip cancellations and interruptions, loss of baggage and travel documents, baggage delay, medical expenses and emergency assistance, illness/injury or death.

Emergency evacuation insurance can be purchased for **USD 30** for the entire duration of your trip. We highly recommend you book this option if not already covered. Benefits include:

- 24 hours access to emergency response with Knight Support First Air Responder
- A dedicated Support Manager to be your link person
- Ambulance response to site of emergency
- Stabilization and relocation to nearest hospital or air ambulance
- 1 free Air evacuation within Tanzania
- 1 free Air evacuation to Kenya

## MONEY & BANKING

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Please bring a few small denomination notes as this will be useful during your trip. Do not attempt to change money on the street or with people who are not licensed as travellers have

been cheated before. Please note that ATM's **only** cash out in Tanzanian Shillings (TSH.) The hotels usually offer these services, however at a lower rate compared to the banks or bureau de change. Any payments required for extra services or fees can be settled when we meet in Arusha before/after your trip.

Approximate exchange rate: 1USD = 2150,- TSHS

Visa/Master Credit Card - Lodges usually charge an extra 6.5% of the total bill to cover bank charges.

Cash payment – Incur no bank charges however, **only post 2006 USD** bills are accepted.

## PAYMENT METHODS

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### CREDIT CARD

If you wish to pay by credit card please request for our credit card form and note to include the 6.5 % bank charges. Kindly email it back to us attached with a clear copy of the front and back of your credit card at least 3 weeks before arrival.

### TIPPING

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Gratuities are anticipated and much appreciated. Tipping is normally paid directly at the end of each day or service, as a gesture of a job well done.

These are general **guidelines** on tipping amounts per person per day/service:

Transfer drivers get on a average Usd 5 -10 per group per transfer.

The safari driver/guides normally get on average Usd 10 per client per day for the safari days.

The lodge waiters and porters Usd 1,- per waiter/porter should cover tips for the entire tip.

### VALUABLES

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Always keep all of your valuables with you at all times, these including: Passport, Money, Airline tickets, Cameras, Credit Cards, Travel and Medical Insurance. Valuables should not be left in hotel/lodge rooms or vehicles.

### SAFARI RULES & PHOTOGRAPHY CUSTOMS

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During game drives in the parks, safari guides are required to stay on official tracks and cannot drive off road except for designated areas allowed by the National Park authorities. You can take as many photographs as you like, however do not disturb the game by way of shouting to draw their attention, feeding them or throwing any items at them. Your safari guide will do all they can to give you the best views of the wildlife. The wildlife is unrestricted in their environment and can be dangerous. Therefore do not get out of your vehicle unless your safari guide says it is safe to do so. In case you need to attend to the "call of nature," ask your safari

guide and when you get out of the vehicle make sure you stay in close proximity in case of any unexpected game. Littering is prohibited. All trash should be kept in the bags in your safari vehicle. Your safari guide will dispose of it responsibly.

It is not permitted to photograph the following: Airfield, Military Installation and Personnel, Police, Prisoners, Bridges and State House. You will require to pay a token for the privilege of photographing the indigenous Maasai people. To photograph locals, first request for their **permission** before taking any photos.

Remember, the safari guides have quite a bit of experience out there in the bush, so please take their advice and don't hesitate to ask them on any uncertainties – *"Hakuna matata!"* – Hope there's no need for a translation!

## RECOMMENDED SAFARI GEAR

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Sun hat, sweater (for cold windy nights out in the wild - about 10<sup>o</sup> Celsius at Ngorongoro), waterproof/ wind proof anorak, light shorts and trousers, swim suit, personal toiletries, sandals/flip flops, casual shoes, safari boots, duffle bag, backpack, flashlight, sunglasses, anti-malaria tablets, sunscreen, money-belt, camera, insect repellent, wet wipes, hand sanitizer, travel smart adaptor (**220V** & UK plugs type are used in Tanzania.)

## TROPHIES:

Please ensure you have the right documentation for all trophies you may purchase from Tanzania. We strongly recommend not to bring trophies into the Country and if so declare them on arrival with proper documentation.

## A GOOD ATTITUDE

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Perhaps the most important thing to bring with you to Africa is a flexible and open minded attitude. Africa is beautiful but is still a developing continent, meaning western idea about efficiency and instant gratification sometimes will not be able to match your home. Please try to adjust to the pace and slip into "African Time."

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### **AMENDMENT OF SERVICE**
